Mission Statement

Tucson Youth Lacrosse Inc., (TYL) , is an Arizona not for profit organization established to promote lacrosse growth specifically in the greater Tucson area; under the guidance of US Lacrosse governances and in concert with the Arizona Youth Lacrosse League (AYLL) & the Arizona Girls Lacrosse Association (AGLA).

The TYL emphasis will initially be at the Junior High / Middle School level and will attempt to:

- Develop 'lacrosse' as a gym class activity in middle schools throughout the Tucson valley and surrounding areas. Teaching the preliminary game of "ChuMash" lacrosse, that will provide the basic skills in a non-contact version of the sport.
- Develop "after school" intermural lacrosse at middle school level to help keep such level kids away from drugs.
- Develop additional JHS and eventually High School level teams that enter the state leagues, (AYLL) & (AGLA).
- Offer community support for training programs & public education, as well as coordination with local schools & recreation departments for adequate field space.
- Offer existing teams in Tucson a central site for recognition of participants and to provide special events promoting the sport of lacrosse.
